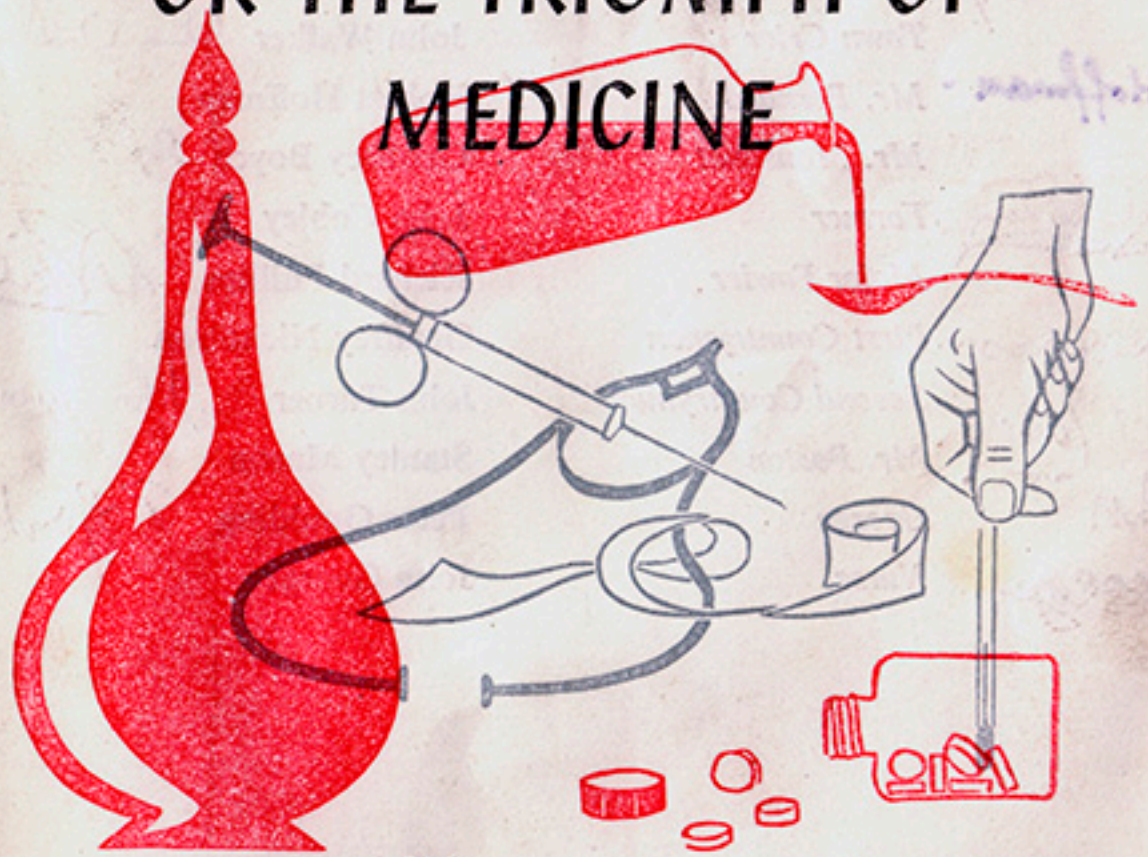

Synopsis of Scenes
